Competition Rules

BACKGROUND

During the 2010/2011 Asia Tour Season the KTA in association with SPLOCS introduced an Old Skool Big Air Competition. This was run on an event-by-event basis, when, and as conditions and time allowed - so lots of good fun and some proper 'airstyling' of a different kind to impress the crowds. We all loved it so this year the KTA Old Skool Project is moving on to hold a full blown Open Asian Championships

CONCEPT

The KTA Old Skool is a serious but off the record event so is not part of any of the overall ranking or points scoring sanctioned disciplines. Still major respect if you win.

Its simple and its fun so be sure to entertain the crowds to win! Big Air and Old Skool combined making it a winner all round.

RULES

- No unhooking
- Big Air scores points
- Big Air with Old Skool moves score more
- Low Old Skool moves score less than the Big Air ones - so GO LARGE!
- Board offs are a good thing, they will score but they score nothing if you don't get back on
- Thumbs up to multi rotations - they score too
- Only jumps/moves in the area will score
- Grab handles on boards are fully allowed
- Go for combinations as they are much appreciated by the spectators and judges alike
- You can't win by just doing your jumps to one side, so be sure to show-off both ways, that does not mean you have to do the same trick both sides as verity is everything

- In the end the judges will be looking at the overall impression of your whole show
- Heat duration and transition times will be announced at the riders meeting by the head judge
- Competitions areas, flags and signals will be as for freestyle unless otherwise stated by the head judge

FORMAT

The format of group or man-on-man or woman-on woman competition will be decided on the day by the Head Judge to best suit the conditions and the numbers entered.

So just like in freestyle the Head Judge can choose to run Old Skool as a single or double eliminator, with the call being made on time and conditions. Also though as its Old Skool the Head Judge could run things as group style expression sessions if it looks like that would better suit the wind and weather at the time. So be ready for anything really.

TITLES

For the KTA Open Asian Old Skool Championships there will be a men's and women's class both open to all nationals with prizes for the first three places and the titles of Asian Old Skool Champions for the winners.

All results will be published so you will get to see where you ended up and how much you need to work to improve to be the Open Asian Champion next year.
